Get your Free Flu vaccine!

We recommend that everyone who is eligible, has their Flu vaccine to protect themselves and their community. We are inviting our patients by text message, however if you are eligible and have not heard from us, please book in. This year our Flu clinics are open at Corner Place Surgery with appointments available on Saturday 23rd & Saturday 30th September and during the week with availability on Monday evenings if needed.

There are Child flu appointments available.

Aged 6 months to 64 in clinical 'at risk' groups. Pregnant Women, Carers, Close contacts of immunocompromised individuals and Patients in long-stay residential care homes

THE NHS APP

The NHS App is owned and run by the NHS. It can be accessed by anyone aged 13 and over registered with an NHS GP surgery in England or Isle of Man.

The NHS App can save you time waiting on the phone for some services. It has 24/7 access to a growing range of health services and information.

What does the NHS App do?

Gives you access to your GP health records, including your medicines, allergies and test results.

Register your organ donation decision.

Order Repeat prescription with just a few clicks and nominate or change the pharmacy you would like your prescriptions sent to.

Book appointments using the NHS App and manage your vaccination appointments.

You can download the NHS App on an iOS or Android device. There is a wide range of health advice using the Health A-Z to check symptoms and treatments and get advice on what to do next. For more urget care, you can access signposting to more urgent 111 online help.

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HANDi App for Child Health

Devon parents/carers can download a free <u>locally developed app</u> to help them manage some of the common childhood illnesses, with advice from child health professionals at their fingertips.

The app has been developed by paediatric consultants and covers conditions, such as:

- Diarrhoea and vomiting
- Chesty baby' illnesses, such as bronchiolitis, Asthma and croup
- Chesty child' illnesses, such as wheezing and Asthma
- High temperature
- Abdominal pain
- Common new-born problems

If you a parent or a carer of a child, download the app now so you have it when you need it.





New Tennis Courts in Torbay

Public Park tennis courts in Torbay have undergone a £500,000 refurbishment through Torbay Council.

Tennis courts have been renovated at Abbey Park in Torquay, Oldway Mansion in Paignton and St Mary's Park in Brixham - with the introduction of online booking and access control.

The online booking is found via the LTA website www.lta.org.uk/play and via Torbay's dedicated booking platform for the tennis courts. This will make it far easier to find and book a court or activity at the tennis courts across Torbay.





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NHS

Six million people in the UK don't know that they have high blood pressure.



If left unchecked it can lead to serious health problems.

Blood Pressure Awareness

High blood pressure, also known as Hypertension, is a serious condition that can cause heart attack or stroke. In most cases people develop high blood pressure because of diet, lifestyle or other medical conditions.

Most people don't realise they have high blood pressure because there are no obvious symptoms and that is why it is important to get your blood pressure checked regularly.

An ideal blood pressure is 120/80Hg.

We have a Pod in the quieter part of the waiting area at Corner Place Surgery and invite you to come in any time to have your blood pressure, height and weight monitored. The results will be added to your health record. Alternatively, if you are over 40, you can visit a community pharmacy and they will send your blood pressure result to us to be reviewed.



After some teething problems at the start, Babblevoice has proven to be an efficient and reliable system that enables patients to choose whether to wait on the line or ask for a call back from the surgery. Babblevoice records all calls for quality purposes and helps us to monitor call wait times so more call handlers are working at busier times. We answered **9013 calls in July** with 553 of those calls received by the prescription team and **8776 calls in August** with 622 to the prescription line. Below are two charts showing the daily calls received each week in July and August.
